

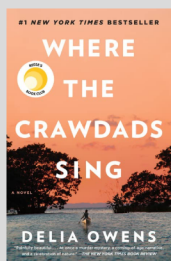

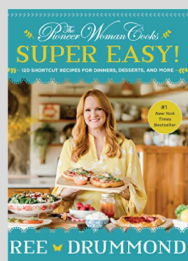

Conditions with the pandemic allowed the library to fully restore all of its library services (play area, in-person programming, in-school outreach, and more).
