As stewards of the facility, the Board of Trustees approved the replacement of the Library's original air conditioning system and fire alarm panel systems. A concrete walkway was installed in the Library's backyard to enable a sturdier pathway for emergency exits. The Library replaced an area of siding as well as a repainting. Lastly, the roof was re-covered. The Board and Staff appreciates the community's support in completing these necessary projects.






